#### 3. EMSA President Report

Mr. Jim Winham, EMSA President reviewed AMR contractor compliance with response times for the months of October 2019 and November 2019 in the Eastern and Western divisions. #### 6. HDE Presentation

Dr. Goodloe introduced Johna Easley, EMSA Chief Administrative Officer, who has been designated the project management lead in the ESO project. Ms. Easley stated that the team working on the ESO project is taking appropriate actions to ensure they are rolling out a product that is as correct and functional as possible.

Dr. Goodloe also introduced Dr. Brent Myers, ESO Chief Medical Officer, to give the board a presentation on ESO's Health Data Exchange product. Dr. Myers started out by giving a brief history of ESO, started 15 years ago by a paramedic working as the EMS quality assurance officer in Austin/Travis County EMS. The company was started as a product to get quality data and evolved into what is now a software engineering company with worldwide reach. The HDE product allows EMS data to enter the hospital's EHR in real time, and conversely return hospital-based care data back to EMS professionals so they can learn patient outcomes to further improve clinical performance. Dr. Myers went on to show what future updates are planned and give examples of how the product will look for the local hospitals and EMS system.
